§2-1-1: PLAN COMMISSION ESTABLISHED; DUTIES:

There shall be appointed by the Village President, with the advice and consent of the Village Board, a Plan Commission, which shall have all the duties and powers conferred upon plan commissions by the statutes of the State of Illinois, the Zoning Ordinance of the Village and such additional duties and powers as may be conferred from time to time by the Corporate Authorities of the Village.

§2-1-2: MEMBERSHIP; TERMS:

The Plan Commission shall consist of a chairman and six (6) other members; in addition, the Village President shall be an ex officio and nonvoting member. Each member shall be appointed for a term of five (5) years, except that the initial appointments to said Plan Commission shall be as follows:

- (A) Chairman, five (5) years.
- (B) One member, one (1) year.
- (C) Two (2) members, two (2) years.
- (D) Two (2) members, three (3) years.
- (E) One (1) member, four (4) years.

The respective terms of office of each appointee to any such board or commission of the Village shall be designated at the time of their appointment.

§2-1-3: VACANCIES IN CERTAIN APPOINTED OFFICES:

Vacancies in offices for the Plan Commission and any other permanent appointed boards or commissions of the Village established pursuant to Illinois statutes or pursuant to this Village Code shall be filled by appointment by the Village President, with the advice and consent of the Village Board, in the following manner:

- (A) Whenever a vacancy occurs in any office of any such board or commission of the Village, other than at the expiration of the designated term of that member, the person appointed to fill that vacancy shall be appointed to fill that specific member's seat for the remainder of the term (i.e., the unexpired term) of the member that is being replaced, even if such term is not so specified in the appointment.
- (B) If a member of any such board or commission of the Village resigns, he or she shall continue in office until a successor has been chosen and qualified to fill such vacancy. If there is a failure to appoint a person to fill such vacancy, when the term of a member of any such board or commission of the Village expires, or if the member of any such board or commission of the Village fails to qualify, the person filling that office shall continue to serve as a member of that board or commission until a successor has been chosen and qualified.
- (C) If a member of any such board or commission of the Village ceases to perform the duties of that office or fails to hold the office by reason of death, permanent physical or mental disability, conviction of a disqualifying crime, or dismissal from or abandonment of that office, the Village President may appoint a temporary successor for that member.
